1987 was the first time that the event was held. The 1992 results were not published in the newsletter so there is no record of those. All we know is the number of finishers.

As we thought, this year's turnout was the lowest ever, although we have had some others which were not much better.

The finish line has not always been in exactly the same place so the times are not necessarily comparable. I think that the distance could have varied by up to about 30 metres (or whatever the distance is between lampposts). However, on the above times you can see that John Heap's time last year was a men's course record. I would expect that to last for a few years. The ladies' course record was set by Vanessa Hamlet in 1994 and, in the same year, Jennie ran the fastest time by a first claim lady. Karon's time this year is the next best. I don't know when Dave Carrington became second claim but some of his times must have been set as a first claim member, so he must hold that record.
